

# **TEXTURA IGNIS**

The Textura Ignis wallpaper collection shines a spotlight on surprising textures you wouldn't immediately expect on a wall. Each design is a beautiful interpretation of an exceptional material, from luxurious textiles like silk, wool, and bouclé to sturdy plasterwork and rope. These unexpected textures come to life in high-quality vinyl, with a stunningly realistic appearance. Ignis is the Latin word for fire; a fitting name for a collection that brings warmth and character to any interior.

#### Katan Silk

An incredibly detailed impression of Katan Silk, a very light, luxurious type of silk. The minor irregularities that are typical of this fabric are also found here. Katan Silk is available in 16 colourways.

#### Ritorto

A semi-plain wallpaper with the tactile look and feel of bouclé. The use of uneven yarns is a trademark characteristic of this fabric, which gives it a caressingly soft and rather casual look while still allowing the material to exude pure luxury. *Ritorto is available in 4 colourways*.

### Shards

Shards features a composition of fragments. It draws its inspiration from plasterwork, which gives the pattern a traditional character. The uneven nature of the wallcovering and incidence of light create extra relief.

Shards is available in 7 colourways.

#### Tamba

The artisanal compositions of fine rope are carefully laid out by hand and coated with a delicate, semi-transparent plaster. They are then faithfully reproduced in vinyl. The name Tamba was inspired by the Indonesian word Tambalan, meaning 'plaster'. *Tamba is available in 10 colourways*.

#### Lana

Lana is a highly detailed rendering of a densely woven wool. The soft hues add depth, creating a wallpaper with an incredibly realistic look.

Lana is available in 10 colourways.

# Montagna

Montagna is a plain wallpaper that takes its inspiration from slightly coarser wool, which is very similar to super soft bouclé. It's a fabric with a somewhat casual but balanced look.

Montagna is available in 7 colourways.

## Ovillo

Elegant Ovillo is an interpretation of very finely woven wool. The realistic colour nuances give this wallpaper its natural, balanced look.

Ovillo is available in 11 colourways.

#### Motas

Motas is a vinyl rendering of woven fibres from the arrowroot plant. The fabric mainly stands out because of the coloured speckles. These speckles – or motas in Spanish – enhance the design's realistic look. The looser bits of fibre make Motas look even more authentic.

Motas is available in 13 colourways.

#### Matiz

This design is a beautiful interpretation of woven banana bark in different hues, which explains its name, Matiz, the Spanish word for hue. The small knots and irregularities are typical of grass fabrics, lending this wallpaper its natural look.

Matiz is available in 12 colourways.

# Sombra

Sombra is an interpretation of a very fine hemp fabric. The highly balanced weave adds a sense of calm and harmony to any interior. Minor irregularities and knots imbue this design with lots of authentic character.

Sombra is available in 11 colourways.

### Mauna

Small pieces of rattan were carefully inlaid by hand into a playful, seemingly random pattern, after which a machine-made version of this artisanal artwork was produced. The alternation of straight and curved lines lends this design a natural look. Mauna is named after Mauna Kea, the highest mountain in Hawaii and a dormant volcano. Mauna is available in 8 colourways.

## Puna

This refreshing semi-plain is an interpretation of hand-woven banana leaves. It was named after the more remote Hawaiian district of Puna, which is dotted with banana trees.

Puna is available in 4 colourways.

# Kona

This cheerful design was inspired by the upbeat, relaxed atmosphere of Kona, the sunny district on Hawaii's west coast. The playful, loose shapes were embroidered with raffia on linen before being transposed to the wall.
